Day 01 Australia/Beijing

We fly from Australia to Beijing today with Qantas. Beijing is the dynamic capital of People's Republic of China. Once the imperial city of Mongol, Ming and Manchu emperors, Beijing is still extraordinarily rich in historical sites and cultural relics. Upon arrival, you are greeted and transferred to CTS (HK) Grand Metropark Hotel or similar 4 star hotel.

Day 02 Beijing (B/L/D)

In the morning you will visit the Tian'anmen Square, the biggest public square in the world, and Mao's Mausoleum if opens. You will also be able to see The National Centre for the Performing Arts, formerly known as the National Grand Theatre, and colloquially described as The Egg. The Centre, an ellipsoid dome of titanium and glass surrounded by an artificial lake, seats 6,500 people in three halls and is 200,000 m2 in size. After lunch, visit the Forbidden City, the vast complex of palaces, which was home to successive Emperors for more than 500 years.

Day 03 Beijing (B/L/D)

Morning tour to the Great Wall at Juyongguan section. Stopover at Beijing National Stadium (Bird's Nest) and Beijing National Aquatics Centre (Water Cube) for taking photos of the spectacular venues. The Great Wall is stretching almost 4,000 miles from the Pacific Ocean to the sands of Central Asia and befittingly crowned one of the ten wonders of the world. Along the way, you will stop at a jade factory where you can watch artisans at work. After lunch visit to the Summer Palace, the largest and the best preserved of all imperial palace gardens, which boasts such delights as the famous Marble Boat and the ornately painted "Long Corridor". For dinner, enjoy a traditional Beijing Duck welcoming banquet.

Day 04 Beijing (B/L/D)

Morning, visit the Temple of Heaven, the 500-year-old Temple houses altars on which sacrifices and offerings were laid to the gods in a glorious setting of gardens, trees and sculptures. In the afternoon, enjoy a pedi-cab tour of Hutong - the 'old city' neighborhoods of narrow alleyways and courtyard gardens, experience local life on a family visit and kindergarten. Shopping at a Silk Factory and famous Yaxiu Market. Enjoy an Acrobatic Show tonight.

Free at leisure to explore this city on you own or go shopping until you drop.

Day 06 Beijing/Australia (B)

Free till transferred to the airport for your flight back to Australia.
