Day 1 Australia/Beijing

Fly to Beijing with Qantas. Beijing is the dynamic capital of People's Republic of China. Which used to be the imperial city of Mongol, Ming and Manchu emperors. Upon arrival, you are greeted and then transferred to your hotel.

Day 2 Beijing (B/L/D)

Morning tour to the Great Wall, stretching almost 4,000 miles from the Pacific Ocean to the sands of Central Asia. Along the way, you will stop at a jade factory where you can watch artisans at work. After lunch visit to Ding Ling underground palace of Ming Tombs, one of the final resting-places for the 13th Emperor of the Ming Dynasty.

Day 3 Beijing (B/L/D)

Morning visit to the Forbidden City, the vast complex of palaces, which was home to successive Emperors for more than 500 years. After lunch, visit to the Summer Palace, the largest and the best-preserved imperial palace garden, which boasts such delights as the famous Marble Boat and the ornately painted 'Long Corridor'. Then "Hu Tong" tour would give you an opportunity to experience the real life of Beijing local residence.

Day 4 Beijing (B/L/D)

Today you will visit the Tian'anmen Square, the biggest public square in the world. After lunch, visiting the Temple of Heaven, the place where the emperors of Ming and Qing dynasty worship the heaven and pray for a good harvest. Enjoy the famous Peking Duck banquet for dinner.

Day 5 Beijing/Hangzhou (B/L/D)

Catch a morning flight to Hangzhou, the city known as "the most beautiful city in the world" by Marco Polo. After lunch, you will take a short cruise tour on the West Lake, where you would surely appreciate the fabled scenery such as "Broken Bridge" "Autumn Moon over the Calm Lake" and "Three Pools mirroring the Moon".

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Day 6 Hangzhou/Wuzheng/Suzhou (B/L/D)

Morning visit to Lingyin Temple, which is among the ten most famous Buddhist temples in China and has a history of over 1,000 years. Then broad coach to Wuzhen, a famous water town under heritage protection. After that, coach to Suzhou.

Day 7 Suzhou/Shanghai (B/L/D)

Suzhou is a small town, famous for its classic gardens in the south of China and often so-called "Oriental Venice". You will visit the Lingering Garden, Tiger Hill and take a short cruise on the Grand Canal dug 1,000 years ago in Sui dynasty. Later afternoon, continue our ride by coach to metropolitan Shanghai.

Day 8 Shanghai (B/L/D)

Morning tour to the Bund, a popular promenade along the Huangpu River, then to the old town with its winding alleyways, lined with shops, teahouses and restaurants, and go to the elegant and tranquil Yu Garden.

Day 9 Shanghai/Australia (B)

Free at leisure prior to be transferred to the airport for your flight back to Australia.
